Instructional video contest

The leading up to the AUATK 2022 conference will feature a Korean language educational video contest. This contest showcases best pedagogical practices in blending technology and Korean language instruction.

The winner will be announced before the event, receive a travel grant up to A\$900, and be asked to deliver a video-making workshop presentation on December 17.

Eligibility to enter the contest

All prospective AUATK conference and workshop participants (presenting and non-presenting).

How to enter the contest

- 1) Submit the AUATK 2022 participation form that you find on the AUATK website.
- 2) By October 30, submit a link to auatk21@gmail.com to allow the AUATK 2022 committee to download your video.

What kind of instructional video can I submit?

Any video that you prepared for your Korean class is eligible. This could be, for example, a video that you made to introduce students to some features of the Korean language, to some aspects of the Korean culture, or any other kind of video that you prepared for your class. Videos can be aimed to any level of Korean language learner (primary, secondary, or university). However, please note that we will NOT consider for the contest:

- Video-recordings of a traditional face-to-face class.
- Third-party videos that you used in class.

How will the video be assessed?

All video will be assessed by an AUATK panel on the following criteria:

- Accurate delivery of information.

- Clarity and conciseness.
- Organisation and flow of the storyboard.
- Video and sound quality.
- Design originality.
- Potential to engage students.
