The Australian Association of Teachers of Korean invites abstract submissions for in-person presentations from established scholars, early career researchers, postgraduate students, and Korean language education practitioners for the 2025 AUATK Korean Language Teacher Workshop, to be held on 13 December 2025 at the Australian National University, Canberra. The event is generously supported by the Korea Education Centre in Sydney and by the Korea Institute at the Australian National University.

Participation and Abstract Submission

The 2025 Workshop will include a series of talks focusing on practical elements of Korean language instruction. The organising committee invites abstract submissions related to all areas of Korean language education. While all relevant proposals are welcome, preference will be given to presentations that aim to introduce the audience to practical insights. The following list provides good examples of possible presentation topics:

- innovative approaches and methods for effective teaching;
- creative classroom techniques, activities, and learning resources;
- case studies highlighting new programs, curriculum designs, or assessment practices;
- other applied topics that address real-world challenges in the Korean language classroom.

Each presentation will be allocated 20 minutes, followed by 10 minutes for discussion. Presentations can be delivered in either Korean or English.

If you would like to present at the workshop, please send your abstract to the association's email (auatk21@gmail.com) by 14 September 2025. Abstracts should be written in English or Korean and must not exceed 300 words. Please include the presentation title, author's name, affiliation, and email address in the submission.

Notification of acceptance for both presenting and non-presenting participants who submitted an EOI will be sent out on 30 September 2025. A registration link will be shared at a later stage.

Travel Grants

Due to limited funding this year, a small travel grant will be provided as partial reimbursement of travel costs for all interstate participants attending the workshop in Canberra. The amount will vary depending on the state participants are travelling from and the final budget availability.

Please note that international participants and established academics on fixed-term or ongoing contracts are not eligible for this support. We appreciate your understanding and aim to assist as many participants as possible within our funding capacity.

Registration

The organisers will waive conference registration fees for all participants. However, participants are required to be 2025 AUATK members before attending the workshop or to join the Association upon participating in the event.
